**10 JOBS FOR BOISTEROUS PEOPLE**

Your whole life, you've been told that you are a "people person." So which jobs are best suited for social butterflies? Here are 10 jobs that will accommodate your personality:\*



**1. PUBLIC RELATIONS SPECIALIST**

**Annual earnings: \$42,000\*\***

Every day, PR folks respond to the media. They establish and maintain relationships with clients, reach out to new ones and, sometimes act as the face and voice behind people and organizations.

**2. SCHOOL COUNSELOR**

**Annual earnings: \$47,000**

Counselors need to be able to relate to students, whether it's discussing academic conduct or bad behavior. On the same token, counselors need to maintain a healthy relationship with parents, approaching conversations about their children with honesty and tact.

**3. MEDIATOR**

**Annual earnings: \$49,000**

You are a neutral party in legal disputes outside of court. You offer suggestions on how to settle a dispute, but it's up to the involved parties to resolve it.

**4. SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS, ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL**

**Annual earnings: \$74,000**

You meet with parents and faculty to discuss educational activities, policies, and student behavioral or learning problems. In addition, you must be able to advise students about personal, academic, vocational or behavioral issues.

**5. EMPLOYEE TRAINING DIRECTOR**

**Annual earnings: \$84,000**

Training directors not only develop and implement training programs for new employees at an organization, they also educate the trainers who instruct new workers directly.

**6. DEMONSTRATOR**

**Annual earnings: \$34,000**

Your sole responsibility is to engage with customers by demonstrating, sampling and explaining products to increase sales.

**7. INSTRUCTIONAL COORDINATORS**

**Annual Earnings: \$63,000**

They need to be able to talk easily with educational committees and advisory groups to learn about certain subject areas and curriculum. Then, they need to know how to communicate that knowledge to others.

**8. RECRUITER**

**Annual earnings: \$49,000**

Recruiters must actively seek out candidates. They must interview and screen applicants, as well as contact them discuss employment possibilities.

**9. EMPLOYMENT INTERVIEWER**

**Annual earnings: \$49,000**

They're responsible for matching job applicants with the appropriate openings in companies, so they need to use their people skills to detect genuinely strong candidates from those who just interview well.

**10. LIFE COACH**

**Annual earnings: \$64,000**

People from all walks of life are enlisting the help of life coaches to determine and achieve personal goals.

**WHAT SERVICES DO YOU OR YOUR EMPLOYER PROVIDE?:**

For more than 30 years, the Tucson Ronald McDonald House has served as a home-away-from-home for families of children receiving medical treatment for a serious illness or injury at a nearby medical facility. The House has served more than 8,000 families from around the world as well as from Southern Arizona and the surrounding region. Our families come from all walks of life, seeking treatment for illnesses such as cancer, birth defects, prematurity and life-threatening trauma.

The cost to support one family for one night is approximately \$90. Families are asked to contribute \$15 per night. If they are unable, the fee is waived. A family is never turned away for their inability to pay.

**HOW LONG HAVE YOU BEEN AT THIS POSITION AND/OR IN THIS BUSINESS?:** I have

been the House Manager since 2008 and have volunteered for RMHC since 2006.

**WHAT LED YOU TO THIS CAREER?:** When my children left home for college I found myself searching for a way to have both a full-time job and to fill the need to care for others. Working with Ronald McDonald House Charities was a natural next step for me. The only difference now is that I have 28 families under the same roof. I certainly found what I was looking for!

**WHAT DO YOU FIND MOST REWARDING ABOUT THIS JOB?:**

Seeing the look of relief on the faces of our children and their families as they come through the front door after another long, hard day at the hospital and hearing them say they are so glad to be back with us. That makes all the work we do worth it.

**IS THERE ANYTHING ELSE YOU WOULD LIKE TO TELL US ABOUT YOUR JOB OR EMPLOYER?:**

The Ronald McDonald House Charities of Southern Arizona is such unique place. Our many wonderful volunteers, our dedicated staff, and our supportive board members are so passionate about our mission that as soon as you walk in you feel that this truly is: "The House that love built"! I can't imagine working anywhere else.
