



WHAT IS *POP TAB PANDEMONIUM?*

- ♥ Ronald McDonald House Charities of Southern Arizona invites local schools of all levels to participate in “Pop Tab Pandemonium.” The program can be used to teach classes the principles of philanthropy, as well as basic math and estimating skills. We have hand-outs and work sheets available for interested teachers.
- ♥ Each school must submit an official Registration Form to participate in the contest. Schools are welcome to sign up through **October 31, 2011**. In an effort to support the ideals of fairness and following rules, **no exceptions or extensions will be allowed.**
- ♥ Participating schools will collect aluminum can tabs to be recycled. Tabs can be delivered to the House any day between 8:30 am and 5:30 pm.
- ♥ The contest will run from October 3, 2011 through April 20, 2012.
- ♥ We will have **two** categories of winners. Winners will be announced in early May 2012 and will have the opportunity to have lunch or a school wide assembly with Ronald McDonald.
 - ♥ The school that collects the most pop tabs by weight.
 - ♥ The school that collects the most tabs per pupil.

HOW WILL POP TAB PANDEMONIUM HELP RMHC?

- ♥ Approximately 1600 pop tabs make one pound and it all adds up! One pound (equal to one quart size zip-top baggie) raises \$.50 for RMHC – every pound helps!
- ♥ 160 pounds helps one family stay one night at our House.
- ♥ 147 pounds pays for the electricity for one day at the House.
- ♥ More than \$7,000 per year is raised for the House through pop tab recycling.
