

WHAT IS POP TAB PANDEMONIUM?

- ▼ Ronald McDonald House Charities of Southern Arizona invites local schools of all levels to join us in our "Pop Tab Pandemonium" contest. Participating schools will collect aluminum pop tabs to be recycled.
- ▼ The program can be used to teach students the principles of philanthropy, as well as math and estimating skills. We have flyers collection canister labels available on our website for interested teachers & school activity coordinators. https://rmhctucson.org/volunteer/#poptabchallenge
- ▼ The contest will run through Earth Day, Wednesday April 22, 2026.



- ▶ Each school must submit a Registration Form to participate. Schools are welcome to sign up online, via fax or mail. Schools can register at any time throughout the contest dates.
- ♥ We will have <u>two</u> categories of winners:
 - ♥ The school that collects the most pop tabs by weight.
 - ♥ The school that collects the most pop tabs by weight per pupil.
- ♥ The winner(s) of the contest will be announced by early May 2026 and will receive a custom Pop Tab Award!



HOW WILL POP TAB PANDEMONIUM HELP RMHC?

1,725 pop tabs make one pound (equal to one quart size baggie) - every pound helps!

300 pounds helps one family stay one night at our House.

5,000 pounds pays for the electricity for one month at the House.

More than \$5,000 was raised for the House in the past two years through pop tab recycling!
